#### Description

Hello,

We find a way to crash oned, it is reproducible:

1. select a running VM
2. select **Network** tab
3. clic **attach nic** green button
4. do not select any nic and clic **Attach** green button

The output is a red error message:

```
end of file reached
```

followed by another one:

```
Failed to open TCP connection to localhost:2633 (Connection refused - connect(2) for "localhost" port 2633)
```

It may be related to [OpenNebula 5.2 segfault](#) discussion on forum.
